

2018 Planning

To assist with planning for the new school year it is important that we have accurate projections of our student numbers. If you know your child/ren will be moving to a new school in 2018 please advise the office. The reverse is equally as important, if you know someone moving into our local intake area requiring a placement for a school aged child in 2018 please ask them to visit the office to enrol. Whilst we don't accept requests for a particular teacher, if your child has an individual need that you would like considered when class lists are made please put this in writing addressed to Ms Perkins and provide these to the office by the 10th November 2017.

Multi-Age Classes (Composite Classes)

Traditionally as a small school all classes at Caversham were a mix of two year levels (multi-age classes). As we have grown single stream classes emerged and in 2018 from Years 1-6 we currently anticipate that up to half of the classes will be single stream and half multi-age. Teaching staff are trained to teach across year levels. Teachers collaborate (work together) in the planning, teaching and assessing cycle as they work towards progress in achievement for all students. Teachers focus instruction on individual student learning needs and meeting the requirements of the WA curriculum.

The first couple of weeks of the school year can be an anxious time for some children as they adjust to a new teacher, new students and a new room. Parents, we need you to work in partnership with teachers to support children when this occurs.
