Kindergarten 2018 Enrolments

We are currently accepting applications for enrolment for the 2018 Kindergarten Program. For a child to be eligible to commence Kindergarten in a Western Australian Government School in 2018 they must turn 4 years of age by 30 June 2018. (Date of Birth Range: 01/07/2013-30/06/2014)

To complete an application for your child to attend our Kindergarten in 2018 we ask that you collect an *Application to Enrol (Part A)* from the school office or you may visit the school websites enrolment tab to obtain a copy. Please ensure it is returned by no later than Friday the **21th July 2016**.

A parent/responsible person applying to enrol a child in a public school should complete this *Application for Enrolment (Part A)* form. It is important to note that this is an application only. Only permanent Australian residents and those children holding an approved visa sub-class number are eligible to enrol in public schools. Children may be enrolled in Kindergarten in one school only, public or private.

Please complete one form for each child. You will also be required to show proof of your child's date of birth (usually birth certificate) and of your usual place of residence. Please read the information provided with your enrolment pack for further details and additional documents that may be required based on your family circumstances.

Dear Parents/Carers

At our School Board meeting on Thursday 27th April new members were given induction into the role of the School Board.

Members signed off the 2017 Funding Agreement between the school and Department of Education.

A letter was received from the City Of Swan regarding -Petition requesting construction of a footpath along Coast Rd.

The following is the Council Recommendations:

That the Council resolve to:

- 1) Construct temporary limestone footpath connections along Coast Road as shown on the attached plan;*
- 2) Construct the section of footpath along Coast Road as shown on the attached plan in red as soon as funding becomes available; and,*
- 3) Write to Main Roads to request formal notification of the outcome of the speed review undertaken along Coast Road in 2016.*

In response to the long waiting times to access child development services the School Board in 2016 supported a two year commitment to screening our Kindergarten children for possible speech development inconsistencies whilst also up skilling our staff on early identification signs. On May 19th NEXT Speech Pathology Services will provide a Kindergarten parent session followed with a week of screening the children.

The Board was informed that the Altone Aquatic Centre will not be available for In-term swimming due to refurbishment. In-term swimming for 2017 will take place takes place in week 9 & 10 of term 3 at Ballajura Aquatic Centre. Due to the extra distance to be travelled the cost may be slightly increased.
