WINNER: INDIGENOUS ACT OF THE YEAR - 2013, 2014 & 2015 WA Music Industry (WAMi) Awards WINNER: 2014 ARTIST OF THE YEAR - NAIDOC and Perth Awards Australian Representative at the 2016 Festival of Pacific Arts (Guam)

Gina is a Balladong daughter; one of the 14 clan groups which make up the Noongar nation, covering the south west corner of Western Australia. She also has links to the Kija people of the east Kimberley region of WA. Her music is informed by an ancient culture and is drawn from a deep well of recent West Australian and an even deeper personal history. By official records, Noongar language is critically endangered (there are less than 400 recognised fluent speakers left). Wanjoo Workshops include story-telling, songs and question time. There is no cost to parents for this workshop.
